

The fiscal year 1993-94 was one of the years followed by a question mark. For the Japanese American Service Committee the accomplishments abounded... but there were a few disappointments along the way.

A mountainous task, the completion of the Keiro Extended Care Center was accomplished. We built the first such facility east of the Rocky Mountains. At the same time our organization had to realize that we could not operate it and it had to be turned over to another owner. While owned by another company, Keiro stands of Foster avenue in Chicago as a lasting monument to JASC and will serve the Japanese American community for years to come.

The theme for our annual report is "Defining a New Agenda," and what that means is that new leadership has taken over our organization. The Sanseis (third generation Japanese Americans) are now the majority on the Board of Directors and for years to come will determine the policies of JASC.

This is welcome. And we hope that in the following years we truly establish "A New Agenda," defining our future course and how we can better serve our community.

The torch is passed to a new generation and knowing that and believing in it, we see nothing but great opportunities.

The centerfold in this annual report will feature in pictures one client's day at our Adult Day Care Center. As we followed her through the day, it appeared that she enjoyed it. We hope that you will too.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Throughout the almost fifty-year history of the Japanese American Service Committee (JASC), we have adjusted to changes in circumstances and the concerns of our members.

We began as a provider of transitional services to Japanese Americans released from relocation camps. The needs at that time were for housing and employment. JASC served that need. We outgrew our LaSalle street headquarters and purchased a building on Sheffield avenue. While these facilities were used by various community groups for cultural, social and religious functions, JASC continued to provide social services to the community. During this time, Nisei leadership replaced Iseis and JASC emerged as source of identity for the community. The service committee picnics are a fond memory of most Sanseis, who grew up in widely scattered communities.

Throughout our existence when the community required service, the JASC responded. We moved to Clark Street because the Viking Hall on Sheffield became inadequate. The JASC focused its service on Issei, first with the sheltered workshop program and later with construction of the Heiwa Terrace a residence building for elderly on Lawrence Avenue and then with the Keiro Extended Care Center facility on Springfield and Foster Avenues. We have succeeded in all endeavors because you, members of the community, have helped with time, money and effort.



The past year, 1993-94, was not an easy year for JASC or the community. Our dreams of owning a nursing home were tempered by our realization that we did not fully understand the overwhelming business of running a medical facility. While those dreams were dashed and everyone was disappointed, the efforts of JASC members to avert a greater fiscal and operational crisis were successful. As a consequence of the generosity of the Thomas Masuda Foundation, JASC was able to provide a smooth transition of the facility during an eventual sale of the facility to the ITEX Corporation.

Our future depends upon whether we can learn from our mistakes and move forward. My sincere appreciation goes to our members and friends who assisted the JASC and our community during this past year and my continued hope is that the JASC will recognize a way to better serve our members as they wish to be served.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The fiscal year 1994 began on an upward beat and anticipation of excitement. The JASC Board discussed the proposed reorganization of the Japanese American Service Committee in preparation for the forthcoming opening of the Keiro Extended Care Center

However, the harsh reality of the financial conditions of the Keiro project forced us to change the ultimate course of our vision. We felt a deep sense of sadness and loss along with many who shared the same dream and helped us to realize our goal. In spite of all, a long-term care facility for Japanese Americans has been completed, existing to provide care and services for Asians for years to come. As the President's Message states, JASC and the Japanese American community owe greatly to the generosity of the Thomas Masuda Foundation. Without this timely and extraordinary gift, a smooth transition and continued care for the residents might not have been possible.

Although other services and programs of the JASC have been provided as planned, throughout the fiscal year it became necessary to critically review the present and long-term future of JASC. The experience with the Keiro Extended Care Center was the greatest test our organization experienced in its history. The JASC has been very progressive in its planning and has successfully responded to the many changing needs and challenges of our community.



After major programs and projects for the senior citizens in the Japanese American community (such as Heiwa Terrace, Keiro Extended Care Center, Adult Day Care, Home Help, Group Programs and Counseling) are in place, the JASC must continue identifying the unmet needs in our community and remain an agency where our people and community can join hands to serve those who cannot obtain assistance elsewhere.

Many services the JASC provided throughout FY 1994 were the joint accomplishment of our dedicated staff, generous and caring volunteers, and the leadership that

the JASC Board has provided.

Continuation of JASC as a viable institution is based on social service and depends primarily on how the agency identifies the needs and interests of the Japanese American community. Of equal importance is how we respond to such needs and interests and the support we receive from the community helping us to achieve the goal of enhancing the quality of life for our people.

This is truly a challenge, but the JASC has met similar challenges in the past and I am confident that this great joint endeavor will continue.

HIGHLIGHTS OF 1993 - 1994

There was a monumental change in the Japanese American Service Committee as Arthur T. Morimitsu after 12 years as president, passed the mantle to Calvin Manshio who became only the 11th president since the organization's inception in 1946. Manshio is a Sansei (third generation Japanese American.)

Several new members were also elected to the Board of Directors and for the first time in the 48-year-old history of JASC the majority of the Board members were Sanseis. The organization before this was controlled by Niseis, second generation Japanese Americans. Challenges for the new Board were substantial, but were met with a commitment to achievement which resulted in substantial accomplishment.

October 11, 1993 saw the Keiro Extended Care Center admit the first clients. It was a time of for celebration, but unfortunately the admittance figures fell way short of expectations. The financial figures through the rest of the fiscal year were such that the Board decided to turn over the operation to a private company.

The Fuji Festival, held in early November, raised \$41,533 in much needed revenue and honored the Chicago Nisei Post 1183. Entertainment was provided by the "Big Band" sound of Steven Hashimoto and the ballroom floor was filled with dancers.

The annual Christmas Delight Sale saw a healthy attendance and grossed \$5,521 for JASC. The Market Day in June, another annual event, had an attendance of more than 1,000 persons and realized \$13,515 for JASC coffers from sale of arts and crafts items, baked goods, plants, china and the rummage sale.

Our Group Services Program in conjunction with the Adult Cay Care, held six Japanese Festivals during the fiscal year. They were the Star Festival in July; Senior Citizen's Day in September of 1993; Moon Festival in October of the same year; New Years Festival in January of 1994; Girl's Day in March of 1994, and Boy's Day in May of 1994.

First of three Japanese cooking classes, sponsored by the Program Committee, took place in February of 1994. Two others followed in April and May and all were highly successful.

All together it can be said that the fiscal 1993-94 had its ups and downs but that the positive overwhelmed the negative by a substantial margin.

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Since its beginning 48 years ago, the Japanese American Service Committee has formed its service programs to serve the changing needs of its client population... the elderly Japanese American community.

In the past we served the Isseis, but there are only a few left today. We now focus on services for the Niseis, but we know that we have to look at the future and anticipate the role that will be played in our organization by the Sanseis (third generation) and the Yonseis (fourth generation) Japanese Americans. Services in the areas of maintaining the Sansei cultural heritage and introducing their children to it, loom of utmost importance to us.

In retrospect, fiscal year 1993-94 has been a productive one for JASC. We served our community with the following programs:

ADULT DAY CARE -- This program served 59 clients during the last fiscal year; an average 20 clients per day. It provided a total of 27,509 hours of service. Of the total 12 were Issei, 3 Nisei and the rest Caucasians or African Americans. Adult Day Care aims to keep the elderly out of institutions and offers activities in a group setting which help older adults to improve their physical and mental condition. Clients get a noon meal and social service and nursing staffs develop individual plans for each client and monitor their progress.

CASEWORK AND COUNSELING -- This service in the past fiscal year worked with 253 clients, providing 2,620 hours of service. Of the total, 211 were Asian, 36 Caucasian and the balance African Americans. One hundred eighty-four were 60 years or over, 62 adults under 60 and seven were children and teens. The counselor speaks Japanese and deals with questions involving financial and health issues as well as formulating future plans for the elderly. This service is welcomed by the elderly Japanese Americans since they cannot obtain counseling anywhere else because counselors in other agencies do not speak Japanese and usually do not understand the cultural background of those counseled.

HOME SUPPORT SERVICES involve cleaning, shopping, laundry, food preparation, personal care, nutritional service and hygiene education to the elderly either at Heiwa Terrace (a senior citizens residential center built and operated by JASC) or at other locations. During the past year the chore housekeepers provided a total of 16,539 hours of service to 152 clients. There are 17 chore workers who served 31 Issei clients, 29 Nisei, 85 Caucasian, nine African American and 98 other Asian. The chore housekeepers are mostly Japanese with whom the clients can identify. The service is especially appreciated by those who have been recently discharged from hospitals and are unable to fully take care of themselves.

GROUP SERVICES is a program which provides educational classes, mature driving, Minyo (folk music and dance), origami (paper folding), kaminingyo (paper doll construction) and other crafts. This program also provides Japanese language and ceramics classes. Special Japanese festivals are observed and presented as authentically as possible. Programs on health and education are presented by this division of JASC as well as city-sponsored nutrition and "Meals on Wheels" services to home-bound elderly. A total of 1,471 individuals were served through these programs last fiscal year. The importance of group services is in providing Japanese Americans with a feeling of ethnic identity and tradition. The service also includes a health maintenance program for the senior citizens in the community. JASC conducts a Health Fair which 76 individuals attended. Free Flu shots were given to 259 individuals and every month free blood pressure readings are offered at JASC. Under the "Meals on Wheels" program, 258 persons participated at JASC and 5,849 meals were served. Home delivered meals totaled 3,972 and went to 15 households.

PARISH NURSE PROGRAM went into a hiatus shortly after the fiscal began when the Parish Nurse decided to leave JASC. In January of 1984, a highly qualified person took over the program and by the end of the fiscal year had put in 500 hours in the activity. About 300 hours of client contact which includes individual encounters (home, hospital visits, phone consultation) and group education programs. About 200 hours in orientation and program development activities.


