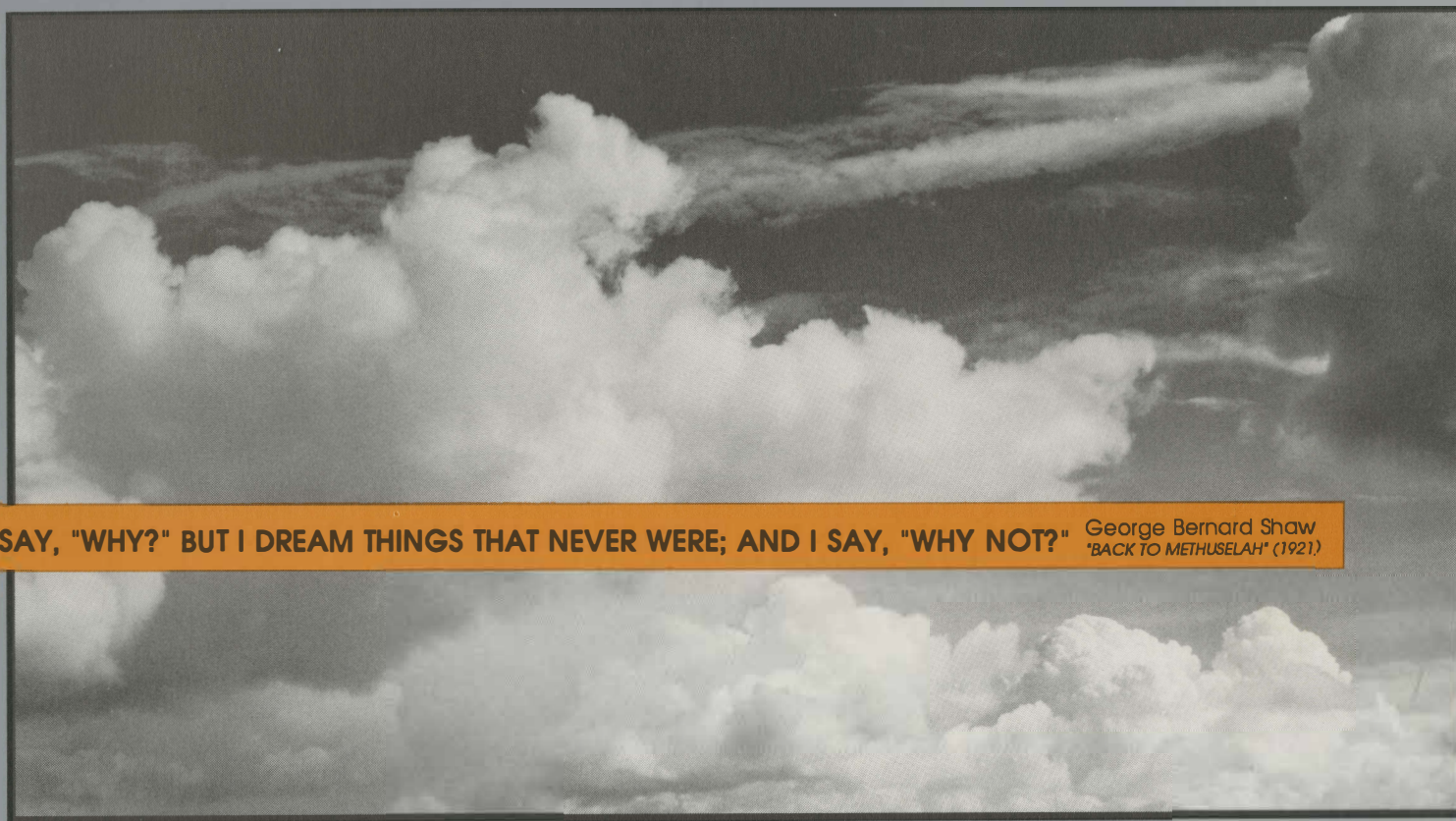

Other activities at JASC continued as usual with excellence and commitment. A special feature in this Annual Report is "The Faces of JASC" a photo essay of pictures

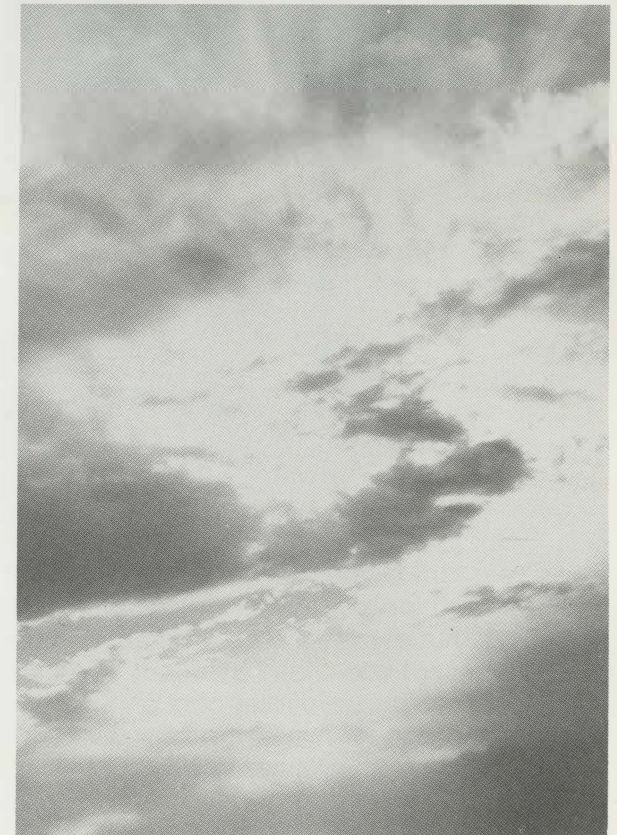
taken by our Adult Day Care program participant Jerry Nishiura. Enjoy.

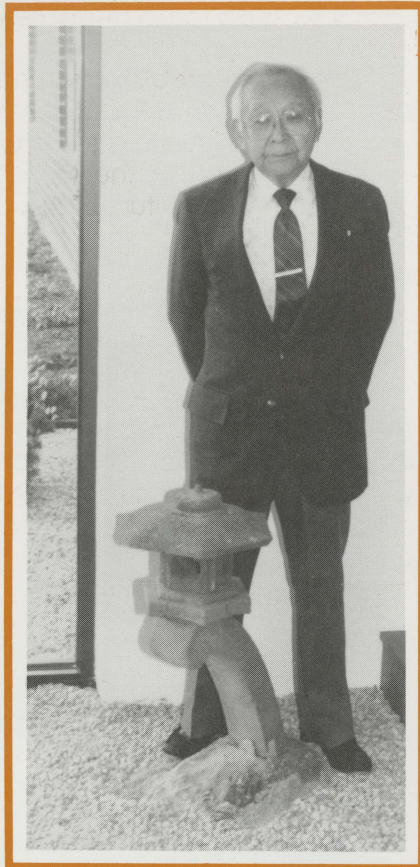
Now the question arises...We have accomplished so much. What is next?

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

This will be my last message as president of the JASC Board of Directors, a position which I have held for the past 12 years. My successor, Calvin Manshio, will bring to the Board a most competent legal mind. He is the former president of the Asian American Bar Association and recently retired from the Governor's Utility Commission. Our community can be assured that the JASC will be in good hands, especially with several old and new Board members who have extensive community service background.

One of our most dedicated members, Betty Nakanishi, who has been associated with our agency from its earliest days, will be moving to Florida. Betty and others who have served as volunteer members are to be congratulated for their years of dedicated service to our community.

Our Keiro Extended Care Center is going to be one of the finest facility of its kind in the State of Illinois, according to many knowledgeable observers. Mary Grondin, the administrator, has assembled top-notch staff members to serve the residents of the nursing home.

Our gratitude for opening the first Asian American nursing home in the entire Midwest area must go to the dedicated efforts of the JASC Executive Director Masaru Nambu who served as the nursing home Project Manager. Credit also is due to Nursing Home Committee Chairman Thomas Teraji and to the members of his committee. The JASC Board of Directors will

not be involved in the operation of the Center, but will direct policy making for the Keiro as well as other functions of the JASC.

Much of the success of our nursing home fund raising campaign was due to the dedication and generosity of the people in our community, especially the members of JASC. Their willingness to donate more than \$2 million to our fund drive, represents tremendous sacrifice for many of them. A number of families gave large donations and foremost was the donation from the Thomas Masuda family of \$300,000. The late Thomas Masuda was a much admired leader of the Nikkei community for his dedicated support of JASC.

The Fuji Festival this year will honor the Chicago American Legion Nisei Post 1183, a much deserved honor for this veterans' organization which has served the community very well. I have been involved with this group for many years and I am grateful that its devotion to our community, especially the Issei, will be recognized.

I appreciated the support JASC received from so many community organizations, and I also wish to acknowledge the faithful support from my severest critic, my wife, Virginia.

The past 12 years have had their ups and downs, but we have achieved many of the goals we set more than a decade ago. To our community and the many others that helped, go my appreciation and my thanks.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

This year has gone fast without realizing that there were events which will be remembered for years to come, and will be providing steadfast financial means to continue services for the Japanese American community.

The eyes of the entire Japanese American population here have been affixed on the Keiro Nursing Home since the construction began in July of 1991. It was not just curiosity why the people kept close observation of this project. It was the concern for the long-term care for the elderly in our community. More than 900 people attended the Open House and witnessed first hand how the Keiro Extended Care Center looked. The facility will be certainly the testimonial that the community is capable of accomplishing a monumental task when it puts minds and resources together to realize a dream.

In the Center, the JASC is providing another legacy for the future generations, insuring that the age-old tradition of respect and care for the aged will be continued at the Keiro (Respect for Elderly) facility.

What the JASC has achieved was only possible with the support of our community. The community has shared the JASC dreams and mission by participating as volunteers, by providing funding support and in many other ways to make our dreams possible.

However, like other ethnic social service agencies, the JASC has experienced financial crisis and has not been able to do

what it wanted to do because of lack of funds.

One of the problems has been that since its inception, JASC has never had the opportunity to create a reserve or an endowment fund for the organization. As we looked at the future, it became apparent that we have to secure better financial resources.

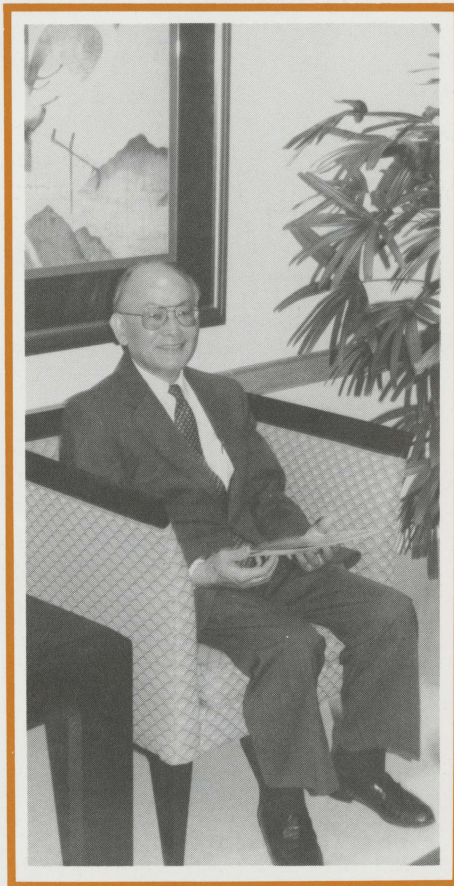
Our efforts toward this goal began in 1980 and these were finally rewarded as JASC received a \$1 million endowment from the Sasakawa Foundation of Japan. This gift will provide our agency with a much needed stable source of income as we turn our attention toward the future.

We hope that the Sasakawa gift is only a basis on which to build and that other organizations and members of the community will respond to our endowment appeals.

Our 47-year history reflects the ability of our organization to change. We emphasize that we are an ethnic agency and that we want to serve the changing needs of our constituents.

Up to the present, our financial limitations have made it necessary that we concentrate on our most urgent concern... the needs of the elderly. As we turn the dream of the Keiro into a day-to-day reality of providing long-term care services for the aged, we can again aim for new horizons. We are looking at serving the younger generations of Japanese Americans and developing programs for the Sanseis and Yonseis -- our future.

HIGHLIGHTS OF 1992 - 1993

Without a question the highlight of the 1992-93 fiscal year was the completion of the Keiro Extended Care Center and the open house on April 24 which attracted more than 900 visitors.

Construction of the multi-million dollar facility was started in July of 1991 and for more than a decade, which preceded the start of the construction, challenges and roadblocks were many. However, now, 12 years since the dream of building the first Japanese American nursing home in the Midwest was conceived, the project is finished.

Those attending the Open House were excited about the state-of-the-art facility which will cater to 180 residents. On April 24, a steady stream of people presented themselves as early as 9 a.m. and toured the four-story building. They heard addresses by a number of dignitaries at noon and the tours continued until mid-afternoon.

The Keiro Open House coincided with the visit to JASC by representatives of the Sasakawa Foundation of Japan which late in 1992 made a \$1 million bequest to our organization. The bequest was the culmination of a five-year effort by JASC President Art Morimitsu and Executive Director Masaru Nambu.

Other events were additional highlights of the JASC year. The Fuji Festival held in early November, raised \$43,300 in much needed revenue and honored the Japa-

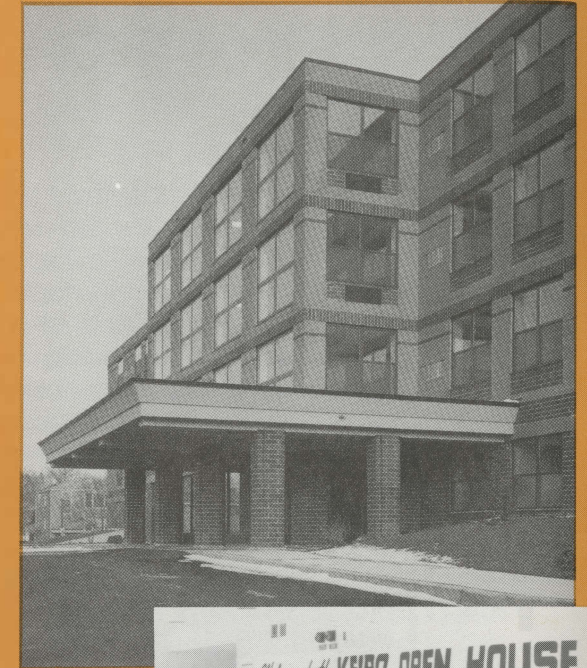
nese Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Chicago. Entertainment was provided by "The Magic and Illusions of Higa," a sophisticated show presented by Bob Higa and his company.

The annual Christmas Delight Sale saw record attendance and grossed more than \$4,000 for JASC. In addition to bargains, the event featured "Kodomo Matsuri", Japanese Children's Festival with Taiko drums, Minyo dancing and a performance by illusionist Higa.

The Market Day in June, another annual event, had an attendance of an estimated 1,000 persons who spent a total of \$12,638 on arts and crafts items, baked goods, plants, china and at the rummage sale.

The Group Services program started a set of new classes during the year which were well attended. Also by the end of this fiscal year we witnessed the retirement of Art Morimitsu, who served JASC as president for the last 12 years. Fortunately JASC can still avail itself of his services, since Art assumed the less demanding duties as chairman of JASC. We welcomed Calvin Manshio as the new president of our organization.

In review it can be concluded that fiscal 1992-93 was a spectacular year for us... a year during which a major dream was realized and accomplishments abounded.

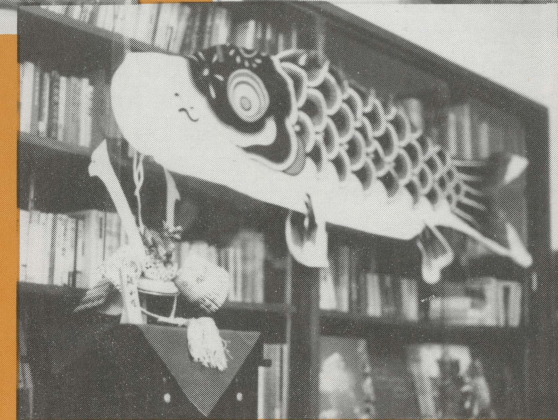

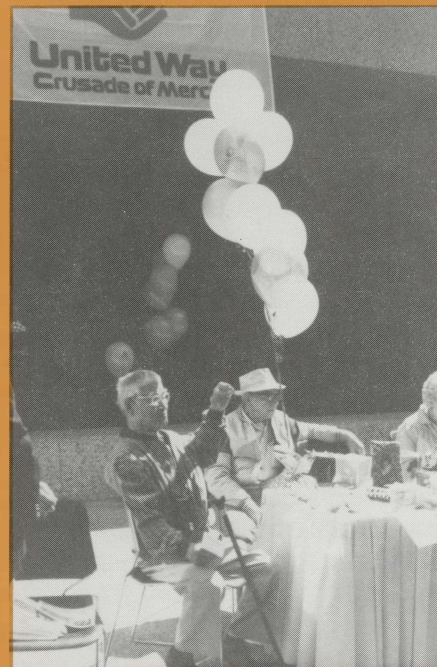

SERVICES WE OFFER OUR CLIENTS

Since its beginning 47 years ago, the Japanese American Service Committee has formed its service programs to serve the changing needs of its client population... the Japanese American community.

In the past we served the Isseis, but there are only a few left today. We now focus on services for the Niseis, but we know that we have to look at the future and anticipate the role that will be played in our organization by the Sanseis (third generation) and the Yonseis (fourth generation) Japanese Americans. Services in the areas of maintaining the Sansei cultural heritage and introducing their children to it, loom of utmost importance to us.

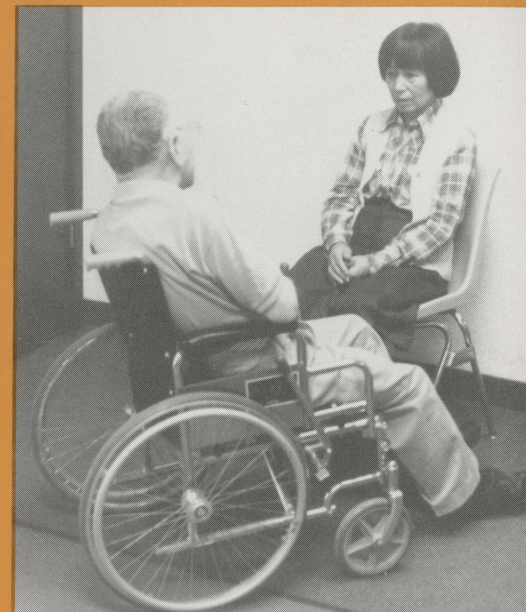
In retrospect, fiscal year 1992-93 has been a productive one for JASC. We served our community with the following programs:

ADULT DAY CARE -- This program served 67 clients during the last fiscal year, on the average 20 clients per day. It provided a total of 28,890 hours of service. It aims to keep the elderly out of institutions and offers activities in a group setting which help older adults to improve their physical and mental condition. Clients get a noon meal and social service and nursing staffs develop individual plans for each client and monitor their progress.

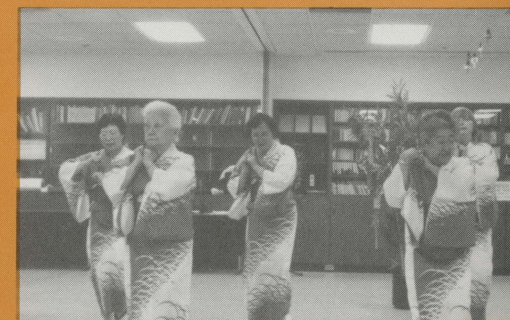
CASEWORK AND COUNSELING -- This service in the past fiscal year worked with 271 clients providing 2,516 hours of service. The counselor speaks Japanese and deals with questions involving financial and health issues as well as formulating future plans for the elderly. This service is welcomed by the elderly Japanese Americans since they cannot obtain counseling anywhere else because counselors in other agencies do not speak Japanese and usually do not understand the cultural background of those counseled.

HOME SUPPORT SERVICES involve cleaning, shopping, laundry, food preparation, personal care, nutritional service and hygiene education to the elderly either at Heiwa Terrace (a senior citizens residential center built and operated by JASC) or at other locations. During the past year the chore housekeepers provided a total of 19,101 hours of service to 152 clients. The chore housekeepers are mostly Japanese with whom the clients can identify. The service is especially appreciated by those who have been recently discharged from hospitals and are unable to fully take care of themselves.

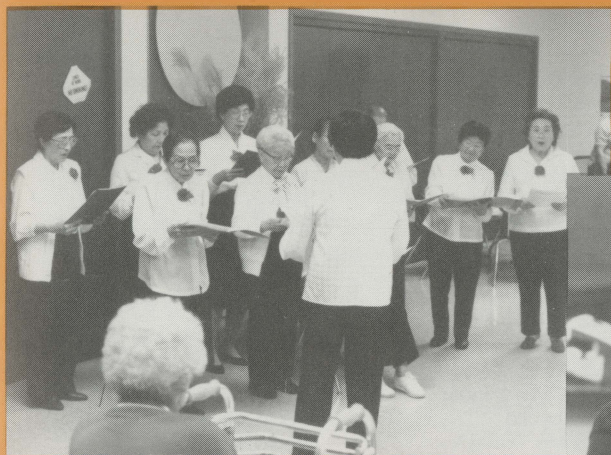
GROUP SERVICES is a program which provides educational classes, mature



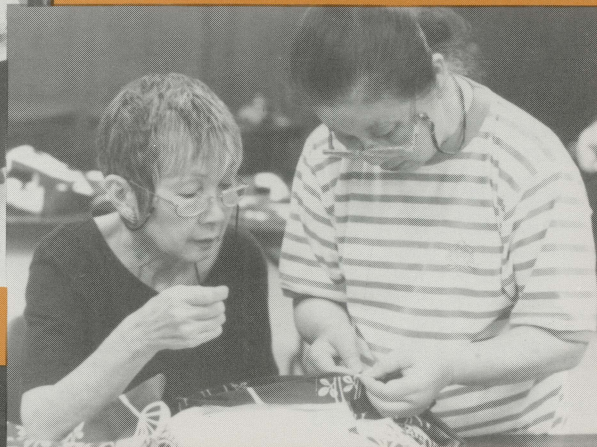

driving, Minyo (folk music and dance), origami (paper folding), kaminingyo (paper doll construction) and other crafts. This program also provides Japanese language and ceramics classes. Special Japanese festivals are observed and presented as authentically as possible. Programs on health and education are presented by this division of JASC as well as city-sponsored nutrition and "Meals on Wheels" services to home-bound elderly. A total of 14,603 individuals were served through these programs last fiscal year. The importance of group services is in providing Japanese Americans with a feeling of ethnic identity and tradition. The service also includes a health maintenance program for the senior citizens in the community.

PARISH NURSE PROGRAM completed its third year of operation as a joint venture with the Swedish Covenant Hospital. It was begun with health issues weighing heavily on the mind of the Japanese American community. The "parish nurse" works with the community in providing health education, health screening and personal counseling on health issues. In the last year, the "parish nurse" spent more than 200 hours in client related activities and was instrumental in helping to conduct the annual Health Fair which was attended by 79 JASC members.
